Protecting members and vital services

Members will be well aware that COVID-19 has caused a severe national crisis with London reportedly an epicentre.

Prospect has welcomed BT's decision not to furlough any employees and maintain jobs for the next 3 months. In a fast changing and uncertain situation an element of certainty is important.

We were not however able to support BT's decision to freeze managerial pay, with many members involved in vital frontline work currently, or with the decision to continue with outstanding People Framework re-organisations.

Mike Clancy, Prospect General Secretary, has raised these issues with Philip Jansen in person. We will return to the issue of pay once the crisis has begun to recede and we will of course continue to represent members in People Framework consultations.

Keeping in touch

With most people currently working from home we have started a series of calls for members to keep people updated on what Prospect is doing. Details of calls will be emailed directly to members.
