Better Workplaces in London?

While no one can go into any office buildings - BT's Better Workplace programme continues to roll out in terms of allocating people - particularly office based and agile workers into the new hubs.

Prospect has been fully consulted and involved since the start back in 2018 and that continues. The Union gets advance notice of every individual move and the reason for it. There are agreements in place around travelling time and travel costs, and we have also been in discussion with BT about the evolving concept of smart working.

No one can know at this point exactly what the post-COVID workplace will look like in terms of occupation levels with distancing etc, but BT's current preference continues to be a mixture of co-located office based working and agile working.

For many, this will be a familiar way of operating but where there are issues and changes Prospect represents members at consultation meetings. If matters cannot be resolved there is a process in place for the Union and BT to review cases and agree what is 'reasonable' and what is not.

The London Office estate

Some members in London will already have been involved in notional moves to new locations depending on the hub where their area of BT plans to be based in future.

Beyond that while BT has done significant work on the office estate in the north and Midlands. So far London has not been addressed in detail.

We know that BT plans to exit BT Centre and has a new HQ at Aldgate, although the number of London based functions is set to reduce.

Prospect has also asked BT for details of plans for London buildings that have significant office-based people including Baynard, Colombo and Faraday. When we get further details, we will communicate with members, but it is worth underlining that just now BT does not have a specific timescale in mind for changes.

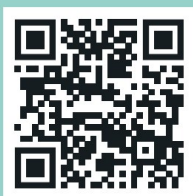
