The Winter of Our Discontent

Prospect members voted to accept a BT cost of living increase for many but far from all towards the end of 2022. Your Union made clear to BT that we weren't happy about the arbitrary cut off involved and that the increase should have gone to all. A key issue in our discussions with the Company so far in 2023 has been to push for this issue to be addressed. There remain other outstanding matters around differentials and scale points.

We are also continuing to raise the issue of three in the office, two elsewhere. While this undoubtedly works well for some, and being in the office has collective benefits, it certainly does not fit all. There needs to be pragmatism and flexibility in the way the policy works.
