	50 hr week (5x 10 hr day)	£2040	£2250	£2370

	40 hr week (5x 8 hr day)	£775	Negotiate	£1200

- Includes a minimum of 1 hour of lunch and screen breaks per day
- Minimum rates, including holiday
- Higher rates may be charged dependent on budget and the editor's experience
- Assistant Editor 'MINIMUM RATE' is a minimum for assistants who have at least one year's worth of experience. More experienced assistants should negotiate up from there.
- 1.5x hourly rate after 10 hours, 2x hourly rate after midnight or on weekends or on bank holidays
- Meals to be provided after 8pm, transport after 10pm

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All figures are inclusive of holiday pay. Minimum rates have been reached after consultation with branch members and non-members in each category. All rates are subject to revision by Bectu Post Production & Facilities Branch.

#### **CANCELLATION TERMS:**

Confirmed bookings (where the editor, assistant, or agent has agreed in writing to accept the work and not accept other work for the agreed dates) are subject to a 50% cancellation fee of up to two weeks. A booking will be considered confirmed if not cancelled in writing 5 business days before commencement.

Employers should bear in mind that these overtime and cancellation terms are the assumed terms of employment. Employers must inform the editor, assistant, or agent if they wish to agree on a variation.

Any proposed changes from members should be notified to the Post Production and Facilities Branch Committee.

All rates are subject to annual revision, on or around the 5th of April, by an amount based on RPI.

This rate card is the result of extensive consultation amongst a large number of freelance Factual and Entertainment editors and assistants and contains rates currently being charged as well as the minimum rate and T&Cs they agree represent fair remuneration for their work. BECTU members are advised to press for these rates

All rates are subject to annual revision, on or around the 5th of April, by an amount based on RPI.
